Mission Leaders - Two positions: 1x 0.8 fte & 1x 0.6 fte

The Executive Director of *Good Samaritan Education* invites applications from suitably qualified and experienced staff for two *GSE* Mission Leader positions located within the Mission Team of *GSE* Services. There is currently a 1.4 fte staffing allocation for these roles which ideally will be organised into one 0.8 fte position and one 0.6 fte position although some flexibility in allocation exists.

The Mission Team exists to steward the spirit of the Good Samaritan Benedictine tradition within the learning communities and governance structures of *Good Samaritan Education* through the provision of multi-targeted and multi-layered formation programs and resources. Formation is focused on the growth of individuals and communities, with the intention of building capabilities for contributing to the mission of *Good Samaritan Education* in response to the Gospel call to bring about the reign of God.

As a Mission Leader in *Good Samaritan Education*, the successful applicant will contribute to the overall vision and strategies that will ensure the authenticity and sustainability of *Good Samaritan Education* and work to build *communio*. The Mission Leaders will report to the Director, Mission Integration and will work closely with the Executive Director, Director of Finance and Resources, Principals, Mission Leaders and staff in *GSE* schools and key personnel in *GSE* Governance structures.

The successful applicants will have a strong personal faith, a willingness to grow in understanding of Good Samaritan Benedictine spirituality, and an understanding and experience of contemporary approaches to formation for mission in schools and other educational settings. The person will have experience in the design and delivery of spiritual formation programs and resources, excellent communication skills, and a demonstrated capacity to be flexible, work collaboratively and build partnerships with others. A sound knowledge of the mission, tradition and values of *Good Samaritan Education* will be an advantage.
